- C. Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.

- A. Matthew 7:21 Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- B. John 6:50-51 v. 50 This is the bread which cometh down from heaven: that a man may eat thereof, and not die. V. 51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.
- C. John 6:54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise up at the last day.
- D. John 6:56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.
- E. Romans 6:5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:
- F. Romans 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- G. Romans 6:23b the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
